Art galleries and outdoor campus are open normal hours during events. However, Putney Hall can be temporarily closed to the public during an event.

The DPM requests event set up no earlier than 9am and event conclusion no later than 10pm.

Additional Information

Photography - with over 2.3 acres of beautiful outdoor (and indoor) space, the options for creative photo opportunities are nearly endless. All permanent sculptures and any art shows can be included in photography, however, no specific photography of art can be sold or reproduced for sale.

Parking - located on the east side of the Granary, can accommodate a limited number of vehicles. Park on the road/ditch at your own risk. No parking is allowed across the road as this is a private residence.

BBQ Pit - renters must provide own firewood; make sure fire is out and completely extinguished.

Costs - \$150/day, \$250/2-days, refer to contract for stipulations and limitations.

Insurance - proof of insurance is required, refer to contract for more details.

Absolutely No Smoking Allowed on Granary Campus or in Buildings.

Venue Options (w/capacities listed)

Putney Hall - original 1912 wood floor and stage: sits about 75 people theater style. Tables and chairs for about 40 people can be arranged for dining. No kitchen facilities but roasters and chafing dishes can be used (not provided by Granary). Men's & Women's restrooms available.

Gazebo - located west of the Granary Gallery, this structure has built in seating around the perimeter and can seat about 40 people. Exterior plug-ins available in this location.

Railroad Deck - this outdoor platform can be viewed by as many people as can stand (150+) or from chairs (about 125).

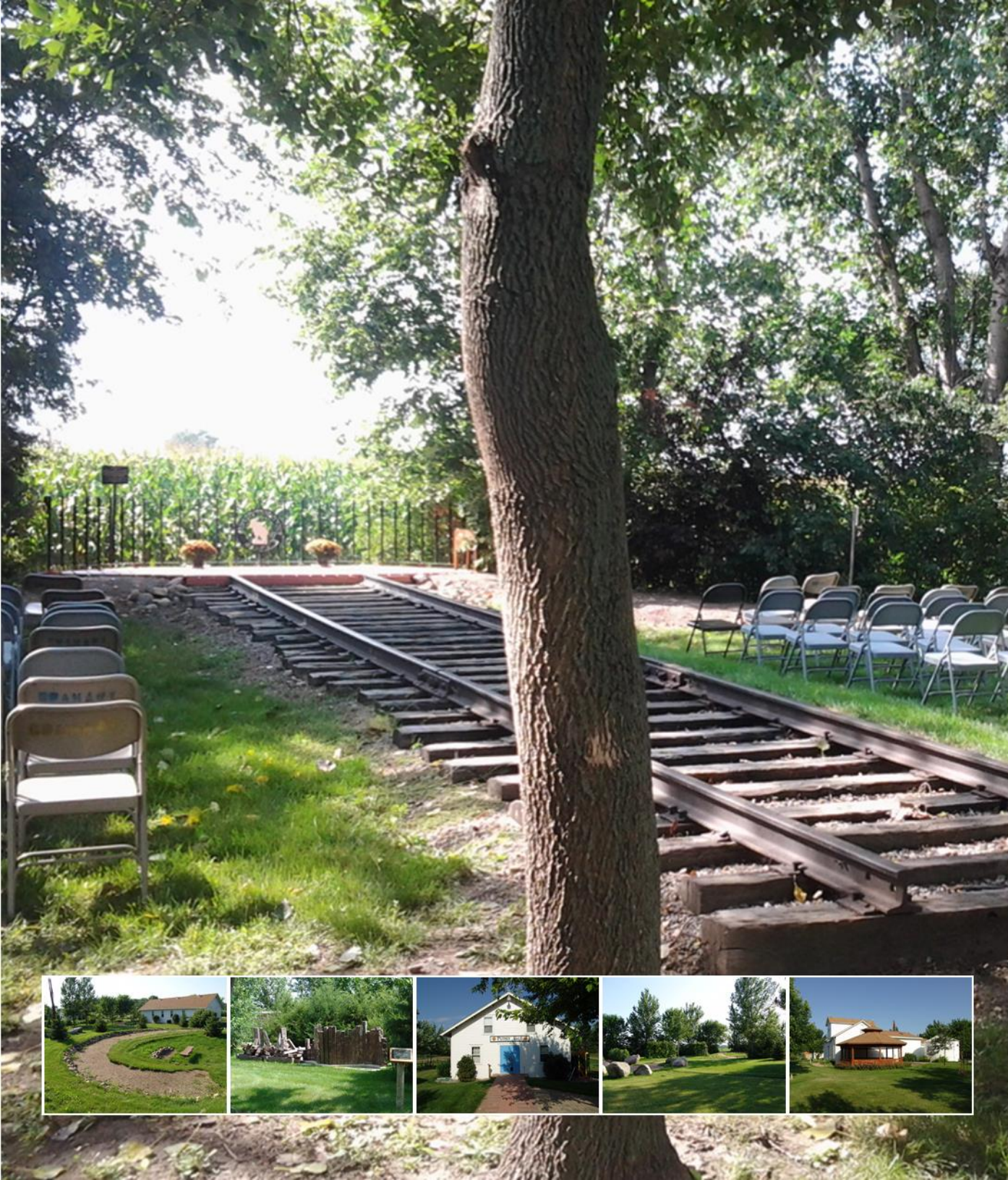
Canopies - 10x10 canopies can be set on the campus grounds to accommodate any preferred site.

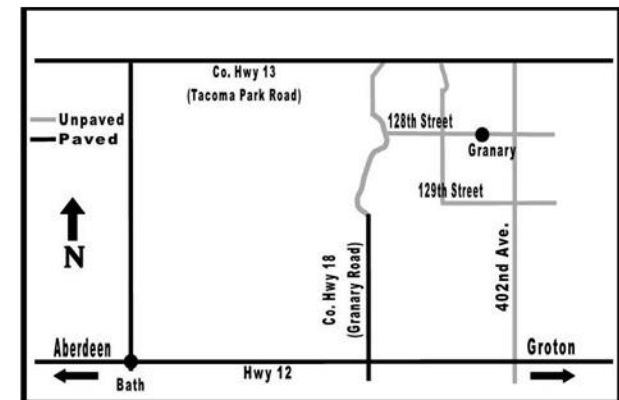
