

4-H ALL-AROUND HORSEMANSHIP TRAVEING TROPHY (BCHTT1)

All Brown County 4-H Horse project members are encouraged to try for the 4-H All-Around Horsemanship Traveling Trophy. This very impressive trophy is awarded each year to the member accumulating the most points. Points are earned for club attendance and participation; talks; posters; horse judging; horse quizbowl; hippology; 4-H horse show; 4-H rodeo; and the member's record book placing. You do not need a horse to participate for the Horsemanship Traveling Trophy. The honor of receiving this impressive trophy at the 4-H Recognition Event will be well worth the time and effort spent keeping the records to be eligible.

The All-Around Horsemanship Traveling Trophy is sponsored by the Hub City Livestock Auction. Each year's recipient receives the huge traveling trophy and a smaller personal trophy at the 4-H Recognition Event. You hold the trophy for the year until it "travels" to the next year's recipient and keep the personal trophy.

You will need an 'Additional Information Sheet' and an "Entry Form". Take a moment to review each so you are familiar with the requirements. There are a few points that need to be stressed.

- The Entry Form must be signed by the member, parent, and club leader to be valid
- Do not calculate sub-totals or total points on the Entry Form, as this will be done for you and your total points will be calculated one your 4-H Record Book has been judged.
- 50 points maximum will be allowed per section (A-J) with actual points considered in case of a tie.
- Keep track of 4-H Horse Show, 4-H Rodeos, any workshops, clinics camps you attend, meetings you attend, committees you serve on-----anything you do throughout the year on the "Additional Information Sheet". Feel free to make copies or additional sheets are available at the 4-H Office.
- Your Entry Form and Information Sheet must both be placed in the front of your completed 4-H Record Book to apply.
- A COMPLETED 4-H Record Book MUST be turned in to be eligible for this or any other award offered the Brown County 4-H Program.
